History and Geography

- Learn about the Ancient Greeks; who they were and where they fit within History.
- Learn about Alexander the Great and his impact on the Ancient Greek empire.
- Learn about the Ancient Greek's influence on democracy, art, sport, science, technology and architecture.
- Learn about the legacy the Ancient Greeks have left behind on the world today.
- Develop map reading skills through the use of an atlas.
- Learn how to use different sources of evidence for historical enquiry.

Foundation subjects

- Explore mark making and creative ways to make a self-portrait.
- Learn Spanish numbers to 30, the months of the year and birthdays
- Develop fundamentals of movement and athletic skills.
- Learn Book Creator tools including inserting, formatting and creating a hyperlink.
- E-Safety: Understand Cyberbullying and know how to keep safe on social media, apps and games.
- Learn about rules, rights, responsibilities & democracy
- Learn about a variety of signs and symbols within religions.
- To describe and compare different kinds of music



Science

- Identify how sounds are made.
- Find patterns between the pitch and volume of a sound.
- Compare and group materials according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases.
- Observe materials and recognise how they change states when heated and cooled.

Numeracy

- Compare numbers up to 9,999.
- Round numbers to 10,100,1000.
- Know Roman Numerals to 50.
- Develop problem solving skills through investigation using money, measures and shape.
- Develop formal written methods for all four operations.
- Develop strategies for mental maths.
- Consolidation of times tables.
- Compare and convert money from pounds to pence.
- Add and subtract fractions.

Literacy

- Read and discuss a range of stories -including myths & legends.
- Write stories, recounts and persuasive letters
- Read information texts about Ancient Greece and Greece today.
- Create information texts about the Greeks using IT.
- Use fronted adverbials correctly.
- Use expanded noun phrases with modifying adjectives.
- Use a range of subordinating conjunctions.
- Using standard English for verbs e.g. I did instead of I done.
- Use inverted commas to punctuate speech.
