Possible case of COVID-19

If a child/student or staff member develops a new continuous cough, or high temperature, or change to sense of taste and/or smell they should:

Go home/be collected and follow NHS guidance on self-isolation and accessing testing. All this is available at **www.nhs.uk/coronavirus**Child should be isolated while awaiting collection. PPE should be worn by staff caring for symptomatic children. Staff member caring should self-isolate if they develop symptoms or child tests positive.

Inform Public Health England's local health protection team if they have not already contacted you. Call **0300 303 8596 and choose option 1 from menu.**

Confirmed case COVID-19

If a child or staff member tests positive for COVID-19 they and everyone in their household should self isolate, as well contacts traced in the event of positive test.

All others in 'bubble' with confirmed case should go into self-isolation for 14 days. Their wider households don't need to unless symptoms develop.

Continue to follow best hygiene practices at all times. Regularly wash hands or use hand sanitiser, avoid touching your face and maintain social-distancing with others.
